Queensland is represented at ANZEMC by three members, Mr Shane Chelepy, Deputy Commissioner Disaster and Emergency Management, Queensland Police Service (QPS), Ms Rebecca McGarrity, Deputy Director-General Policy, Department of Premier and Cabinet (DPC) and Major General Jake Ellwood (Retd), Chief Executive Officer, Queensland Reconstruction Authority (QRA).
