

- 2. Extend Bitumen Sealing McIvor Road 3km. Grant Funding Sought Approximately \$750k- 5% co-contribution
- 3. Everlina Retail Precinct Joint Building Upgrade Commercial Space and Supermarket Grant Funding Sought Approximately \$1.5m 40% co-contribution as per the funding guidelines.





- 4. Design & Documentation of the Pavement Design relating to the Remote Airstrip Upgrade Program R9. Grant Funding Sought Approximately \$250k 5% co-contribution
- 5. Upgrade Aerodrome as per CASA Annual Safety Report. Widen and Lengthen Existing Runway and Potential Seal Upgrade, Bulk Earthworks, and Modelling Stormwater Review. Grant Funding Sought Up to \$3m 5% co-contribution
