# HOPE VALE ABORIGINAL SHIRE COUNCIL

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## Introduction

This report provides an overview of outstanding Hope Vale Aboriginal Shire Council's ("Council") debtors and their ageing balances, including recommendations on how to address same.

## Recommendation

That Council:

1. Note the report.
2. Write off aged debtor balances greater than six years old (\$171,215.70) where recovery is not legally or economically viable.
3. Engage legal representation to issue formal correspondence to debtors with balances aged between four and six years (\$109,308.95).
4. Write to all debtors with balances aged between 30 days old and four years (\$1,208,906.36) using Council letterhead correspondence.
5. Delegate authority to the CEO to negotiate payment arrangements with outstanding debtors.
6. If not already developed, create a debtor recovery policy. Should one exist, review and ensure that it remains fit for purpose.

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## PURPOSE OF REPORT

The purpose of this report is to allow Council to consider and review its aged debtor balance in order to allow it to determine how best to action those outstanding balances.

Debtors that are being dealt with as part of this resolution are split between three different categories:

- Debtors ageing over six years;
- Debtors aged between four and six years;
- Debtors aged between 30 days old and four years;

A complete schedule of the aged debtors balances as at 8 December 2025 are also included in Schedule A, along with the categories noted above.

Debts greater than six years are, generally, statutorily (i.e. legally) barred from having legal proceedings engaged against them for their recovery. This means that once the six-year time frame has passed, the debt generally becomes "statute barred", meaning that the creditor (e.g. Council) loses the legal right to enforce the debt through the courts. The purpose of statute barring claims greater than six years is to encourage the timely resolution of financial obligations.

If a debt is older than six years and no legal action has been taken in respect of that debt, nor any method of extension of that time applies within that period, the debtor is no longer legally obligated to repay it, and the creditor cannot take legal steps to recover the amount owed.

As part of this report, and as a direct result of being statute barred, Council will need to consider writing off particular debtor balances. When Council writes off debtors, it essentially acknowledges that those debtors are unrecoverable and removes them from its balance sheet as an asset. As a matter of financial reporting, Council has for many years recognised a 'provision for doubtful debt' that acknowledges the difficulties that are likely to be faced in collecting some debtors (e.g. those that are old). This amount roughly mirrors those debtors aged 6 years and greater.

If Council undertakes the above process, this will have several effects and impacts on Council's financial statements:

1. There is a reduction of assets for the written off amount;
2. There is a recognition of an expense for the amount that Council writes off. That expense is incurred in the particular financial year that the write-off occurs. Council currently already has a provision for a portion of the bad debt but will likely need to recognise a further bad debt expense as the provision is unlikely to be large enough to cover the full amount of the write-offs. This provision will be reduced to the extent of what Council considers to be a bad debt (i.e. if the provision is recorded on Council's balance sheet as \$200,000, and bad debts total \$220,000, the provision will be reduced by \$200,000 and a further \$20,000 bad debt expense recognised); and
3. Council's accounting system records are more accurate, as they correctly reflect the unrecoverable amount of the relevant debtor and do not over-state the amount of assets that Council has.

Separately, Council will also need to consider arranging for the CEO to instruct a lawyer to draft correspondence to those aged debtors with balances between four and six years. If this correspondence is drafted to be in template format, there is no reason that it ought not be issued to other debtors that are aged beyond acceptable terms. This instruction should ultimately remind those debtors of their legal obligation to pay for their outstanding debts, but also of the moral obligation to contribute to the Council's development, especially where the contribution relates to debts that the debtor owes for services provided by Council.

As part of the above consideration, Council will also need to determine whether to allow the CEO to have a delegated authority to negotiate payment terms with the relevant debtors and make determinations on Council's behalf on how to address the outstanding amounts owed by the aged debtors.

## Key issues for consideration

Council currently has the following outstanding debtor balances, split into the three different categories as identified above:

The total balance of debtors outstanding as at 1 December 2025 is \$1,904,108.27 – represented in **Schedule A**.

It is proposed that Council arranges for debtors aged over six years to be written off (\$171,215.70 in total), which would result in a reduction of Council's assets by that amount. These debtors are listed at **Schedule B**. From an accounting perspective, that would mean that an expense during this financial year will be incurred for that amount (or the provision be reduced by that amount). It is important to express that a written-off debtor does not directly translate into a cash reduction for Council – there is no cash movement involved in writing off debtors.

It is also recommended that Council arranges to instruct a lawyer to draft template correspondence that can be updated and issued to outstanding debtors with aged balances that are outside of acceptable terms. Priority ought to be given to those balances aged between four and six years (\$109,308.95) to attempt to recover the outstanding amounts before they are at risk of becoming statute barred and remind the debtors of their obligation to meet their outstanding debts (both from a legal and moral standing). These debtors are listed at **Schedule C**.

As part of the instruction to the lawyer, Council should also allow the CEO to negotiate the payment terms associated with the outstanding debts on Council's behalf should such a request be received from the debtor.

It is also recommended that Council itself writes to all debtors aged between 30 days and four years (\$1,208,906.36) to demand payment for outstanding amounts. These debtors are listed at **Schedule D**.

We have been unable to identify if Council has a debtor recovery policy that Council has adopted. A policy should be developed and circulated for Council consideration. Should one exist, it ought to be reviewed and updated to ensure that it remains fit for purpose.

### Financial considerations

Overall, the collection of outstanding accounts is beneficial to Council's financial position as it supports the unrestricted cash balance of Council. This, in turn, supports Council's ability to invest in the Hope Vale Area (e.g. via wages paid and services rendered).

#### Debtors aged over six years:

Debtors aged over six years currently total \$171,215.70. It is proposed that Council writes this amount off, resulting in a reduction in its assets and the incurring of an expense (or a reduction of the provision) for the write-off.

#### Debtors aged between four and six years:

Debtors aged between four and six years currently total \$109,308.95. It is recommended that Council arranges for a lawyer to draft correspondence that can be issued to these outstanding debtors as a priority

The financial repercussion of this step means that there will be a cost to Council for arranging for the lawyers to draft correspondence that can be issued to the debtors, as well as potential time delays in the recovery of the outstanding debts (noting that there is no certainty that the debtors will pay the full amount outstanding).

#### Debtors aged between 30 days and four years:

Debtors aged between 30 days and four years currently total \$1,208,906.36. It is recommended that Council writes to these debtors and reminds them of their obligations to Council as a priority. Note that some debtors, such as QBuild, are potentially waiting on further supporting documentation or need to have their invoices issued by Council. This is something that should be considered on a case-by-case basis.

### **Risks**

From a debtor management perspective, the greatest risk is that the longer a debtor remains uncollected, the greater the chance of non-payment. Council has missed the opportunity to receive payments due to non-collection historically (e.g. both through direct payment from debtors and by missing out of dividends paid by liquidators of insolvent entities).

From a Council operation perspective, the main risks involved in the proposed approaches result in drafting correspondence to debtors by the lawyers, which may result in:

1. Costs being incurred by Council for debts that may not be recoverable;
2. Upset debtors who may still resist paying their aged debts, especially when they have not been followed up for these outstanding amounts previously (and, in the majority of instances, for some years); and
3. Inability of some debtors to pay their outstanding amounts.

In respect of writing off the aged debtor balances, the risks associated with same include:

1. Debtors adopting a “if we leave it, they’ll leave it” attitude whereby they ignore correspondence or follow-ups for outstanding amounts with the expectation that after a certain amount of time, Council will just write their debts off. This could be countered with regular follow-ups and subsequent letters being issued by lawyers at an earlier stage in future; and
2. A detriment to Council’s balance sheet and profit and loss statement for the reduction in the debtor balance and the expense that would impact Council as a result of the write-off.
