

COUNCIL REPORT Meeting 15 November 2023



Item 1: Meetings Attended

- Mayor and Councillors attended the Council meeting on 25 October 2023 in Hope Vale.
- Mayor and CEO undertook an inspection of the QBuild display village/MMC Training Centre
 in Brisbane on 31 October 2023. Torres and Cape Hospital and Health Service (TCHHS) in
 conjunction with Queensland Health is planning to construct new modular staff
 accommodation dwellings across the sector, including in Hope Vale. The displays were
 prototype 1, 2 and 3-bedroom modern homes designed to help attract essential workers to
 regional and remote Queensland
- Mayor, CEO, and Operations officer attended the Technical Working Group meeting held Hope Vale on 6 November 2023.
- Mayor, Cr Bruce Woibo and Cr Barry Bowen attended the Torres Cape Indigenous Council Alliance (TCICA) Inc. meeting held in Cairns on 8 and 9 November 2023.

Item 5: Hope Vale Campus School Awards Evening

Item 5: Growing Respect Joint Mayoral Taskforce

The Queensland Government established the Domestic and Family Violence Prevention Council to support greater community understanding about domestic and family violence and to challenge the values, beliefs, attitudes and behaviours that trivialise, excuse or perpetuate this abuse.

Working at the primary prevention level, the Council partners with government, business and community stakeholders to champion local community-led action and leadership in creating social change. Through enhanced education, understanding and place-based responses, the Domestic and Family Violence Prevention Council will ensure all Queenslanders can play their part in ending domestic and family violence.

The Domestic and Family Violence Prevention Council (via the Department of the Premier and Cabinet) have identified the need to form a collaborative partnership with Cook Shire Council, Hope Vale Aboriginal Shire Council and Wujal Wujal Aboriginal Shire Council to take a proactive approach to addressing and preventing DFV and youth issues across the 3 local government areas. These 3 LGA's share a range of community service providers as well as Police and Courts districts.

Accordingly, the first Growing Respect Joint Mayoral Taskforce meeting will be held in Cooktown at 9am on 20 November 2023, followed by a public meeting to be held at 10am.
