

Automated Generators at Child Care, Aged Care, and Business District – Generators ordered. Due to a bottleneck in international trade, the generators are not scheduled to arrive until February 2021.

ITEM 8 Other Matters

Item 8.1 Building Better Regions Round 5

Building Better Regions Round 5 is currently open. It closes on the 5th March 2021. The funding is focused on Tourism related infrastructure. Grants range from \$20,000 to \$10,000,000. Projects must be previously designed and in a position to be 'shovel ready' within 3 months of announcement of approved projects. Announcements are estimated to be announced mid year.

A potential project for this funding stream may be Hope Vale short term accommodation. This project has an existing design that had been utilised for previous unsuccessful funding applications to alternative grants. The design *Appendix 1* is aimed at using the free block of land across from the aged care on Thuppi St (the Ex Women's Shelter Site).

Recommendation: That Council endorse;

- a) The application to be made for the construction of short-term accommodation
- b) The design in Appendix 1 for application under the Building Better Regions Fund Round 5
- c) The location of the short-term accommodation to be at 176 Theile Street (the Ex Women's Shelter site)
