### Item 12.0: OPERATIONS MANAGER REPORT

### **Building & Construction**

#### **Once Off Federal Housing Allowance**

Council is still yet to receive a formal agreement from the Department of Housing. Operations has followed this up and been informed the final approval is sitting with the DG of Housing.

Once received Operations and the building department will undertake designs and plans to be approved by the Department of Housing. It is anticipated that construction on ground will not commence until into the new year (2022).

### **Civil Construction**

Civil crew is back completing the Gamaay Construction Project, estimated finish Mid-October. They will then move onto commence works on McIvor Rd under the W4Q program. This and the Culvert installation on Airport road should see the Civil Department out until the end of year.

Elim Beach has now been sealed. The seal contractor will return early December to complete the Airport Road/Banana Farm Connection (Heavy Vehicle Bypass), and what has been completed to date on the McIvor Road project.

#### **Essential Services**

Routine daily water testing, and weekly third-party water testing results indicate there are no current issues with water quality or capacity. Town water is of a safe and drinkable water standard.

No issues with sewerage.
