

COUNCIL REPORT Meeting: 20th January 2021



ITEM1: Building & Construction

Item 1.1. Current Update

No major progress on building projects to report since the December Council report due to the annual 2-week council break, and most contractors taking extended holidays. With monsoonal activity starting to increase and supply routes beginning to be affected, the Council building programs really don't develop a lot of momentum until late March early April.

Currently most contractors are focused on completing Government Housing that must be completed before the school start, and continual Do and Charge maintenance for Public Housing.

Item 2.1 Monsoon Season

Civil has been lining draining and repairing damage from rain received over the Christmas break. This is typically a quite time due to monsoonal activity. Civil will continue to operate with a skeleton crew focusing on maintenance including sign replacement, pot holing etc.

Item 7.12. Queensland Resilience and Risk Reduction Funding (QDRRRF)

Automated Generators at Child Care, Aged Care, and Business District – Generators ordered. Due to a bottleneck in international trade, the generators are not scheduled to arrive until February 2021.

ITEM 8 Other Matters

Item 8.1 Hope Vale Security Contractor

The previous Council budgeted \$30,000.00 to launch a security contractor trial over 6 months in 2018, the council then extended the trial up to the value of another \$60,000.00. The contract meant that a mobile security guard would do security surveillance over Council assets. Big Boys Security was the successful tendered in undertaking the security contract over the past 18 months. The approved budget has now been exhausted and the current Council will have to make the decision as to whether the contract remains funded, is cancelled, or goes back out to tender.

Recommendation: The security budget is continued, and Council put the renewed contract out to tender.
